CIRFF has longstanding experience in health-related big data analysis and has achieved a high level of expertise about integrating many different data sources (administrative, pharmaceutical and hospital discharge data, clinical data from different third-party sources). Moreover, the Centre is supporting the use of these data in health care decision making. The Centre monitors pharmaceutical expenditure and utilization in Campania region (about 6 million of inhabitants), operating a Campania Region Data-Warehouse, called CaReDB (Campania Region Data Bank) containing ~1.2 billion records.
