EUROmediCAT is a collaborative network of congenital anomaly registries and institutions active in research on medication safety in pregnancy. MFIR is one of the public partners of the EU-IMI ConcePTION project. MFIR works with the congenital anomaly surveillance networks EUROCAT in Europe, RELAMC in Latin America, and sSCAN in sub Saharan Africa.
