The main research focus in the last five years was on COVID-19, based on the large project SCIFI-PEARL (Swedish Covid-19 Investigation for Future Insights – a Population Epidemiology Approach using Register Linkage). Another key area currently is pharmacoepidemiology, based on the project HI-SPEED (Health Impact - Swedish Population Evidence Enabling Data-linkage).
