We leverage data from observational studies, clinical trials, and healthcare surveys, and apply either direct or indirect data linkages to enrich the data structure. Using pharmacoepidemiologic designs and advanced statistical models, we inform decision-making, enhance clinical care quality, quantify disease burdens, support drug approvals, explore drug repurposing opportunities, and assess the economic and market impacts. All of this is done while promoting responsible medicine use and integrating sustainable practices.
