PRINTO initially included 14 European countries (about 93 countries, 685 centres worldwide with 1526 members today), with the goal to foster, facilitate and co-ordinate the development, conduct, analysis, and reporting of multi-centres, international clinical trials and/or outcome standardisation studies in children with paediatric rheumatic diseases (PRD).
