Based on a core of senior staff of around 80 scientists, the CMNS is also dedicated to training of predoctoral and postdoctoral fellows, including an International PhD Programme. Research at the CMNS covers four main areas of interest: fundamental and translational research, clinical pharmacology and epidemiology (applied to cardiovascular diseases, diabetes and oncology, cognitive and behavioural disturbances of old age, health services, and care of patients), environmental sciences and citizenship and welfare
