Adverse Events

To date (31/12/15): 7 neurological adverse events (0.42% incidence).

- Migraine with 1 eye visual symptoms (scotoma) for 2 hrs – self resolved without medical attention immediately after treatment (pt reported at post procedure check on 25/3/15).
- 30 minutes visual disturbance then headache for 60 minutes immediately after treatment. No other neurological symptoms and fully resolved. Patient took Rizatriptin 10mg as treatment for usual migraine with aura.
- 19 days post treatment right internal capsule infarct resulting in left arm/hand weakness. Fully recovered
- Occipital headache for 90 minutes post procedure. No neurological or visual symptoms. Fully recovered

- Migraine without aura, rapidly resolved after few minutes. Fully recovered
- Right arm weakness for 10-15 minutes. Fully recovered. Thought to be possibly related to anxiety by reporting clinician.
- Migraine with visual aura (both eyes) immediately after treatment, resolved after 10 minutes

Action Plan:

Send individual consultants personal emails requesting renewed co-operation/chasing up absence of completed proformas.

Re-approach sites that have not currently responded to requests for participation.
